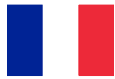

Electric locomotive BB 7200 of the French State Railways.

New Design 2021!

- Delicately designed model with separately applied plug-in parts
- Filigree design of the pantographs
- In digital mode with switchable headlights and tail light
- Digitally switchable sound functions

In 1976 the French State Railways (SNCF) bought 237 multiple-current-system locomotives of the series BB 7200 for the use in the French DC network. The design of the locomotives with the so-called "nez cassé" (broken nose) was created by the frenchman Paul Arzens, who at that time was also responsible for the design of several other SNCF locomotives. From 1999, the locomotives were allocated to various business divisions and have since been used in front of various types of trains.
